



SwiftCap **Grid EA**

Complete Setup Guide

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Part 1: Getting Started (General Setup)

This section applies to all SwiftCap EAs. If you've already completed these steps, skip ahead to Part 2.

Step 1: Purchase the EA

You can purchase SwiftCap Grid EA through either of the following options:

Option A — SwiftCap Website (Recommended)

1. Visit the product page: <https://swiftcapeas.com/eas>
2. Choose your preferred plan (Monthly, Quarterly, or Lifetime)
3. Complete the checkout through Whop
4. After purchase, log into your SwiftCap Dashboard at <https://swiftcapeas.com/dashboard>
5. Your license key and set files will be available in the dashboard

Option B — MQL5 Market

1. Create an MQL5 account at [MQL5](#) if you do not have one
 2. Click Register in the top right corner, fill in your details, and verify your email
 3. Visit the product page: <https://www.mql5.com/en/market/product/164484>
 4. Click Buy and complete the payment
 5. The EA is now tied to your MQL5 account
 6. You can activate it on up to 10 devices depending on the license
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Step 2: Install MetaTrader 5

If you do not have MT5 installed yet:

1. Go to your broker's website (we recommend [IC Markets](#) or [FP Markets](#))
2. Download MetaTrader 5 for your operating system (Windows, Mac, or use a [VPS](#))
3. Install and open the application
4. Log in with the trading account credentials provided by your broker

Important: Make sure your account type supports hedging. Most brokers offer this option when opening the account. If unsure, contact your broker's support.

Step 3: Install the EA

The installation process depends on where you purchased the EA.

If You Purchased Through SwiftCap Website:

1. Log into your SwiftCap Dashboard at <https://swiftcapeas.com/dashboard>
2. Go to your Licenses page
3. Copy your license key
4. Download the EA file (.ex5) from the dashboard
5. In MT5, go to File, then Open Data Folder
6. Navigate to MQL5, then Experts
7. Paste the downloaded .ex5 file into the Experts folder
8. Restart MT5 or right-click in the Navigator panel and click Refresh
9. The EA will now appear under Expert Advisors in the Navigator panel

If You Purchased Through MQL5 Market:

1. In MT5, go to the top menu: Tools, then Options
2. Click the Community tab
3. Enter your MQL5 login and password
4. Click OK
5. In MT5, go to the Toolbox panel at the bottom of the screen
6. Click the Market tab
7. Click Purchased at the top
8. Find SwiftCap Grid EA in the list
9. Click Install
10. The EA will now appear in your Navigator panel on the left side under Expert Advisors.

Step 6: Enable Automated Trading in MT5

Before any EA can trade, you need to enable these settings:

Global Settings:

1. Go to **Tools** → **Options** → **Expert Advisors**
2. Check the following boxes: → Allow automated trading → Allow DLL imports (If purchased through website)
3. Click **OK**

Toolbar Button:

1. Look at the top toolbar in MT5
2. Find the **Algo Trading** button
3. Make sure it is **enabled** (the button should appear active/green)

> If Algo Trading is disabled, no EA will place trades — even if everything else is set up correctly.

Step 7: Set Up Your Broker Account Correctly

For the best EA performance, make sure your broker account has these settings:

- Account Type > Hedging (not netting)
- Spread Type > Standard account with low spreads
- Leverage > 1:100 or higher
- Broker > [IC Markets](#), [FP Markets](#), or any reliable low-spread broker

> **Why Hedging?** Hedging accounts allow the EA to hold multiple positions on the same symbol at the same time. Netting accounts combine them into one, which breaks the EA logic.

Step 8: Use a VPS (Strongly Recommended)

A VPS (Virtual Private Server) keeps MT5 running 24 hours a day, 5 days a week — even when your computer is off.

Why you need a VPS:

1. EAs only trade when MT5 is open and connected
2. If your PC shuts down, loses internet, or goes to sleep — the EA stops
3. A VPS ensures the EA never misses a trade

Recommended VPS: [ForexVPS](#) — low latency, built for trading

How to set up:

1. Purchase a VPS plan
2. Connect to it via Remote Desktop (RDP)
3. Install MT5 on the VPS
4. Log into your broker account
5. Install and attach the EA (same steps as above)

Part 2: SwiftCap Grid EA — Product Setup

Now that MT5 is ready and the EA is installed, let's set up the Grid EA specifically.

What Is SwiftCap Grid EA?

SwiftCap Grid EA is a professionally designed mean reversion grid Expert Advisor focused on stability and consistent performance over time. The strategy has been actively used on personal trading accounts since 2023 without any further optimization, demonstrating its robustness across different market conditions and regimes.

Unlike over-optimized grid systems, SwiftCap Grid EA relies on:

- Conservative trade management with small take-profit targets to exit the market earlier
- Multi-symbol diversification across three correlated pairs to reduce exposure and smooth the equity curve
- Risk control focused design rather than aggressive recovery
- No curve-fitting or frequent optimization
- same logic running since 2019 across different market cycles

This approach minimizes prolonged drawdowns and allows small profits to compound steadily over time.

Strategy type: Mean Reversion Grid

Risk approach: Grid martingale — conservative settings with multi-symbol diversification

Design philosophy: Long-term portfolio growth with compounding

Important: This EA uses a grid martingale strategy. Like all grid and martingale-based systems, it carries a higher level of risk, including the possibility of significant drawdowns. Make sure you fully understand how this strategy works and the risks involved before using this EA.

Supported Instruments: AUDCAD | AUDNZD | NZDCAD

Step 1: Understand the Setup (No Set Files Required)

SwiftCap Grid EA does not require any set files. All parameters are pre-configured inside the EA. This is a plug and play installation.

You do not need to download or load any external files. Simply attach the EA and configure the symbol inputs as described below.

Step 2: Add Symbols to Market Watch

Before attaching the EA, make sure all three trading symbols are visible in your Market Watch:

- In MT5, open the Market Watch panel (press Ctrl+M if it is not visible)
- Right-click inside the Market Watch panel and select Show All or search for the symbols individually
- Make sure the following symbols are listed: — AUDCAD — AUDNZD — NZDCAD

Note the exact symbol names as they appear in your Market Watch — some brokers add suffixes like AUDCAD.r or AUDCADm

You will need to type these exact names into the EA inputs in a later step.

Step 3: Open the Correct Chart

1. In MT5, go to File, then New Chart
2. Select AUDCAD
3. Set the timeframe to M15 (15 minutes)

Important: You only need one chart. Do not attach the EA to multiple charts. The EA trades all three symbols from a single AUDCAD M15 chart using the multi-symbol input.

Step 4: Attach the EA to the Chart

1. In the Navigator panel (left side), expand Expert Advisors
2. Find SwiftCap Grid EA
3. Drag and drop it onto your AUDCAD M15 chart
4. A settings window will pop up

If you purchased through the SwiftCap website, the EA will ask for your license key during this step. Enter the license key from your SwiftCap Dashboard.

Step 5: Configure the EA Inputs

In the settings window that appeared:

1. Click the Inputs tab
2. Find the symbol input fields
3. Add all three recommended symbols exactly as they appear in your Market Watch: — AUDCAD — AUDNZD — NZDCAD

Type the symbol names exactly — if your broker uses suffixes (for example, AUDCAD.r), you must include the suffix. All other parameters are pre-configured. You do not need to change anything else unless you want to adjust the risk settings.

Step 6: Configure Risk Settings

Choose the appropriate risk setting based on your account size:

- Accounts \$1,000 or below: Use 0.01 Fixed Lot
- Accounts above \$1,000: Use Medium Risk setting
- For long-term portfolio growth: Use Low Risk settings

Ensure sufficient free margin and leverage on your account, especially on smaller accounts. A leverage of 1:100 or higher is recommended for smaller accounts.

Step 7: Confirm EA Settings

Before clicking OK, verify these things in the settings window:

Common tab: — Allow Algo Trading is checked

- Inputs tab: — All three symbols are entered correctly (AUDCAD, AUDNZD, NZDCAD)
- Symbol names match exactly what appears in your Market Watch
- Risk setting is appropriate for your account size
- If purchased through SwiftCap website, your license key is entered correctly

Click OK to attach the EA.

Step 8: Verify the EA Is Running

After attaching, check the following:

- **Chart header:** You should see the EA name in the top-right corner of the chart (for example, SwiftCap Grid EA)
- **Smiley face:** A small smiley face icon should appear next to the EA name — this means it is active
- **Experts tab:** Click the Experts tab in the Toolbox at the bottom. You should see initialization messages from the EA — no red error messages
- **Algo Trading button:** Make sure it is still enabled (green) in the top toolbar

If you see a sad face instead of a smiley face, the EA is not allowed to trade. Go back to Tools, then Options, then Expert Advisors and make sure automated trading is enabled.

Important Reminders

- Do NOT attach the EA to multiple charts. It trades all three symbols from one single AUDCAD M15 chart.
 - Do NOT use set files. Everything is pre-configured inside the EA.
 - Make sure all three symbols (AUDCAD, AUDNZD, NZDCAD) are added to your Market Watch before attaching the EA.
 - Type symbol names exactly as your broker displays them, including any suffixes.

Quick Reference Card

SwiftCap Grid EA

- **EA Name:** SwiftCap Grid EA
- **Strategy:** Mean Reversion Grid with multi-symbol diversification
- **Instruments:** AUDCAD, AUDNZD, NZDCAD
- **Timeframe:** M15 (15 minutes)
- **Chart Required:** One AUDCAD M15 chart only
- **Set Files:** Not required — all parameters are pre-configured
- **Account Type:** Hedging required
- **Minimum Deposit:** \$500 (can work with any balance)
- **Leverage:** 1:100 or higher recommended for smaller accounts
- **Spread Type:** Standard account with low spreads recommended
- **Risk Style:** Grid martingale — conservative with multi-symbol diversification
- **Risk Settings:**
 - 0.01 Fixed Lot for accounts \$1,000 or below
 - Medium Risk for larger accounts
 - Low Risk for long-term growth
- **VPS:** Strongly recommended for 24/5 stable operation
- **Broker:** Any reputable broker with reliable execution
- **Multi-Chart:** No — attach to one chart only, EA handles all symbols internally

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Troubleshooting

EA is not trading:

- Is Algo Trading enabled? (green button in toolbar)
- Are all three symbols (AUDCAD, AUDNZD, NZDCAD) added to your Market Watch?
- Are the symbol names typed exactly as they appear in your Market Watch, including any broker suffixes?
- Is the chart set to AUDCAD on the M15 timeframe?
- Is the EA attached to only one chart? Do not attach it to multiple charts.
- Do you have sufficient free margin? Grid strategies require margin for multiple open positions.
- If purchased through SwiftCap website, is your license key entered and valid? Check your dashboard.

Check the Experts tab for error messages.

EA shows a sad face:

- Go to Tools, then Options, then Expert Advisors.
- Enable "Allow automated trading."
- Re-attach the EA to the chart.

No trades appearing:

- The EA uses a mean reversion approach — it waits for price to move away from the mean before entering.
- Be patient, the EA opens positions based on market conditions.
- Make sure the market is open (forex markets are closed on weekends).
- Check the Experts tab — if you see normal logs, the EA is working.

Wrong symbol name:

- Some brokers add prefixes or suffixes (for example, AUDCAD.r, AUDCADm).
- The symbol names in the EA inputs must match exactly what is in the Market Watch.
- If they do not match, update the symbol names in the EA inputs.

Margin or balance issues:

- Grid strategies hold multiple positions simultaneously — ensure your account has enough free margin.
- If your account is \$1,000 or below, use the 0.01 Fixed Lot setting to keep risk manageable.
- Consider increasing leverage to 1:100 or higher on smaller accounts.
- If margin calls occur, reduce the risk setting or increase your deposit.

License key issues (SwiftCap website purchases only):

- Log into your dashboard at <https://swiftcapeas.com/dashboard> to verify your license is active.
- Make sure you copied the full license key without extra spaces.
- Check that your subscription is active and not expired.
