Complete Setup Guide

Part 1: Getting Started (General Setup)

This section applies to all SwiftCap EAs. If you've already completed these steps, skip ahead to Part 2.

Step 1: Purchase the EA

You can purchase SwiftCap trinity EA through either of the following options:

Option A — SwiftCap Website (Recommended)

1. Visit the product page: <https://swiftcapeas.com/eas>
2. Choose your preferred plan (Monthly, Quarterly, or Lifetime)
3. Complete the checkout through Whop
4. After purchase, log into your SwiftCap Dashboard at <https://swiftcapeas.com/dashboard>
5. Your license key and set files will be available in the dashboard

Option B — MQL5 Market

1. Create an MQL5 account at [MQL5](#) if you do not have one
 2. Click Register in the top right corner, fill in your details, and verify your email
 3. Visit the product page: <https://www.mql5.com/en/users/swiftcapeas/seller>
 4. Click Buy and complete the payment
 5. The EA is now tied to your MQL5 account
 6. You can activate it on up to 10 devices depending on the license

Step 2: Install MetaTrader 5

If you do not have MT5 installed yet:

1. Go to your broker's website (we recommend [IC Markets](#) or [FP Markets](#))
2. Download MetaTrader 5 for your operating system (Windows, Mac, or use a [VPS](#))
3. Install and open the application
4. Log in with the trading account credentials provided by your broker

Important: Make sure your account type supports hedging. Most brokers offer this option when opening the account. If unsure, contact your broker's support.

Step 3: Install the EA

The installation process depends on where you purchased the EA.

If You Purchased Through SwiftCap Website:

1. Log into your SwiftCap Dashboard at <https://swiftcapeas.com/dashboard>
2. Go to your Licenses page
3. Copy your license key
4. Download the EA file (.ex5) from the dashboard
5. In MT5, go to File, then Open Data Folder
6. Navigate to MQL5, then Experts
7. Paste the downloaded .ex5 file into the Experts folder
8. Restart MT5 or right-click in the Navigator panel and click Refresh
9. The EA will now appear under Expert Advisors in the Navigator panel

If You Purchased Through MQL5 Market:

1. In MT5, go to the top menu: Tools, then Options
2. Click the Community tab
3. Enter your MQL5 login and password
4. Click OK
5. In MT5, go to the Toolbox panel at the bottom of the screen
6. Click the Market tab
7. Click Purchased at the top
8. Find SwiftCap trinity EA in the list
9. Click Install
10. The EA will now appear in your Navigator panel on the left side under Expert Advisors.

Step 6: Enable Automated Trading in MT5

Before any EA can trade, you need to enable these settings:

Global Settings:

1. Go to **Tools** → **Options** → **Expert Advisors**
2. Check the following boxes: → Allow automated trading → Allow DLL imports (If purchased through website)
3. Click **OK**

Toolbar Button:

1. Look at the top toolbar in MT5
2. Find the **Algo Trading** button
3. Make sure it is **enabled** (the button should appear active/green)

> If Algo Trading is disabled, no EA will place trades — even if everything else is set up correctly.

Step 7: Set Up Your Broker Account Correctly

For the best EA performance, make sure your broker account has these settings:

- Account Type > Hedging (not netting)
- Spread Type > Standard account with low spreads
- Leverage > 1:100 or higher
- Broker > [IC Markets](#), [FP Markets](#), or any reliable low-spread broker

> **Why Hedging?** Hedging accounts allow the EA to hold multiple positions on the same symbol at the same time. Netting accounts combine them into one, which breaks the EA logic.

Step 8: Use a VPS (Strongly Recommended)

A VPS (Virtual Private Server) keeps MT5 running 24 hours a day, 5 days a week — even when your computer is off.

Why you need a VPS:

1. EAs only trade when MT5 is open and connected
2. If your PC shuts down, loses internet, or goes to sleep — the EA stops
3. A VPS ensures the EA never misses a trade

Recommended VPS: [ForexVPS](#) — low latency, built for trading

How to set up:

1. Purchase a VPS plan
2. Connect to it via Remote Desktop (RDP)
3. Install MT5 on the VPS
4. Log into your broker account
5. Install and attach the EA (same steps as above)

Part 2: SwiftCap Trinity EA — Product Setup

Now that MT5 is ready and the EA is installed, let's set up the Trinity EA specifically.

What Is SwiftCap Trinity EA?

SwiftCap Trinity EA is a multi-strategy Expert Advisor that combines four independent trading systems into one unified and disciplined framework. Instead of relying on a single market condition, Trinity is built to adapt. The result is a more balanced, structured, and consistent automated trading approach.

Key characteristics:

- Combines four fully independent trading systems in one EA
- Each system targets different market conditions and timeframes
- Internal diversification with precise execution control
- Advanced account-wide protection designed specifically for prop firm environments
- Plug and play — no set files required, all parameters are pre-configured
- Fully compatible with prop firms

Strategy type: Multi-Strategy (Intra-Day Swing, Session Trading, Daily Range Capture, and a fourth price action based system)

Risk approach: No grid, no martingale — disciplined multi-system framework

Supported Instrument: Gold (XAUUSD)

The Four Independent Systems**System 1:** Intra-Day Swing Strategy

- Identifies key market structures during the initial phase of the trading day
- Holds positions to capture intraday momentum

System 2: Simplified Session Trading

- A clean and adaptive session-based strategy

- Designed to perform consistently across different market conditions

System 3: Daily Range Capture

- Trades based on the previous day's highs and lows
- Uses trailing-based exit controls for optimized trade management

System 4: Price Action Strategy

- Price action based market momentum capture
 - Adds further diversification within the same instrument
-

Each system runs independently with:

- Individual enable or disable control
- Separate risk settings per system
- Option to use risk percentage, fixed USD amount, or fixed lot size
- Separate magic numbers and trade comments for transparent tracking

This structure provides internal diversification while maintaining precise execution control.

Advanced Account Protection — Built for Prop Firm Rules

While each system trades independently, Trinity includes intelligent account-wide protection designed specifically for funded accounts and professional risk management:

- Maximum daily risk limit that disables all systems if reached

This protection layer makes Trinity especially suitable for prop firm environments where daily loss limits, overall drawdown rules, and consistency requirements must be respected.

You benefit from diversification without compromising strict risk discipline.

Compatible prop firms and brokers include:

 - Fusion Markets
 - FTMO
 - FundedNext
 - The 5%ers

Step 1: Understand the Setup (No Set Files Required)

SwiftCap Trinity EA does not require any set files. All strategy logic, entry timing, exit rules, breakeven management, and trailing parameters are pre-configured.

You do not need to download or load any external files. Simply attach the EA and configure your risk settings and system selection.

You focus on risk management and system selection. The EA handles execution.

Step 2: Open the Correct Chart

1. In MT5, go to File, then New Chart
2. Select XAUUSD (Gold)
3. Make sure the symbol name matches exactly what appears in your broker's Market Watch

The EA works on any timeframe — for better visuals, M5 or M15 is recommended

Important: You only need one chart. Do not attach the EA to multiple charts. One instance manages all four systems.

Step 3: Attach the EA to the Chart

- In the Navigator panel (left side), expand Expert Advisors
- Find SwiftCap Trinity EA
- Drag and drop it onto your XAUUSD chart
- A settings window will pop up

If you purchased through the SwiftCap website, the EA will ask for your license key during this step. Enter the license key from your SwiftCap Dashboard.

Step 4: Configure System Selection

In the settings window that appeared:

Click the Inputs tab

- You will see controls for System 1, System 2, System 3, and System 4
 - Enable or disable each system based on your preference:
 - To run all four systems: Enable System 1, System 2, System 3, and System 4
 - To run specific systems only: Enable only the ones you want and disable the rest
 - Each system can be toggled independently
-

Step 5: Configure Risk Settings

For each enabled system, set the individual risk parameters:

- Choose your risk mode: risk percentage, fixed USD amount, or fixed lot size
- Set the risk value for each system independently
- Recommended approach: start conservative and adjust after observing live behavior

Account-wide protection settings:

- Set your maximum daily risk limit (especially important for prop firms)

Risk guidance:

- Accounts \$1,000 or below: Use conservative settings or fixed lot of 0.01 per system

- Larger accounts: Adjust risk percentage per system based on your risk tolerance
- Prop firm accounts: Configure daily risk limit to match your firm's rules

Step 6: Confirm EA Settings

Before clicking OK, verify these things in the settings window:

Common tab:

- Allow Algo Trading is checked

Inputs tab:

- Desired systems are enabled (System 1, 2, 3, and/or 4)
- Risk settings are configured for each enabled system
- Account protection settings are configured
- If purchased through SwiftCap website, your license key is entered correctly

Click OK to attach the EA.

Step 7: Verify the EA Is Running

After attaching, check the following:

- **Chart header:** You should see the EA name in the top-right corner of the chart (for example, SwiftCap Trinity EA)
- **Smiley face:** A small smiley face icon should appear next to the EA name — this means it is active
- **Experts tab:** Click the Experts tab in the Toolbox at the bottom. You should see initialization messages from the EA — no red error messages
- **Algo Trading button:** Make sure it is still enabled (green) in the top toolbar

If you see a sad face instead of a smiley face, the EA is not allowed to trade. Go back to Tools, then Options, then Expert Advisors and make sure automated trading is enabled.

Important Reminders

- Do NOT attach the EA to multiple charts. One instance manages all four systems from a single XAUUSD chart.
- Do NOT use set files. Everything is pre-configured inside the EA.
- Broker server time must be GMT+2 or GMT+3. This EA is designed specifically for brokers operating on GMT+2 / GMT+3 server time. Performance may differ on other time zones because some strategies are time-based.
- Make sure your account type supports hedging.
- Configure account protection settings before going live, especially on prop firm accounts.

Broker Time Zone Notice

This EA is designed specifically for brokers operating on GMT+2 / GMT+3 server time. Some of the four systems are time-based, meaning performance may differ significantly on other time zones.

How to verify your broker's server time:

- Look at the time displayed on your MT5 charts
- Compare it to the current GMT time
- If your broker shows a time that is 2 or 3 hours ahead of GMT, you are on the correct server time

- If your broker does not use GMT+2 or GMT+3, this EA may not perform as intended. Consider using a compatible broker for best results.

Compatible brokers include IC Markets, FP Markets, Fusion Markets, FTMO, FundedNext, The 5%ers, and other similar environments.

Quick Reference Card

1. **EA Name:** SwiftCap Trinity EA
2. **Strategy:** Multi-Strategy — four independent systems in one EA
3. **Systems Included:**
4. **System 1:** Intra-Day Swing Strategy
5. **System 2:** Simplified Session Trading
6. **System 3:** Daily Range Capture
7. **System 4:** Fourth Independent Strategy
8. **Instrument:** XAUUSD (Gold)
9. **Timeframe:** Works on any timeframe
10. **Chart Required:** One XAUUSD chart only
11. **Set Files:** Not required — all parameters are pre-configured
12. **Account Type:** Hedging required

14. **Leverage:** 1:100 or higher recommended for smaller accounts
15. **Broker Server Time:** GMT+2 or GMT+3 only
16. **Prop Firm Compatible:** Yes — includes daily risk limit
17. **Risk Style:** No grid, no martingale — disciplined multi-system framework
18. **VPS:** Strongly recommended for 24/5 stable operation
19. **Multi-Chart:** No — attach to one chart only, EA handles all four systems internally

Troubleshooting

EA is not trading:

- Is Algo Trading enabled? (green button in toolbar)
- Is at least one system enabled in the EA inputs? (System 1, 2, 3, or 4)

- Is the chart set to XAUUSD?
- Does the symbol name match exactly what appears in your Market Watch?
- Is your broker on GMT+2 or GMT+3 server time? The EA will not perform correctly on other time zones.
- Is the EA attached to only one chart? Do not attach it to multiple charts.
- Has the daily risk limit been reached? If so, all systems will be disabled until the next trading day.
- If purchased through SwiftCap website, is your license key entered and valid? Check your dashboard.

Check the Experts tab for error messages.

EA shows a sad face:

- Go to Tools, then Options, then Expert Advisors.
- Enable "Allow automated trading."
- Re-attach the EA to the chart.

No trades appearing:

- Each of the four systems waits for its own specific market conditions before entering.
- Not all systems will trade every day — this is normal and by design.
- If the market is ranging or outside the active trading windows for the enabled systems, no trades will appear.
- Be patient and check the Experts tab — if you see normal logs, the EA is working.

Wrong symbol name:

Some brokers add prefixes or suffixes (for example, XAUUSD.r, XAUUSDm).
The symbol on your chart must match exactly what is in the Market Watch.
If it does not match, close the chart and open a new one with the correct symbol.

Broker time zone issues:

- This EA only works correctly on GMT+2 or GMT+3 broker server time.
- If your broker uses a different time zone, some or all systems may not generate signals correctly.
- Verify your broker's server time by checking the time displayed on your MT5 charts.
- If needed, switch to a compatible broker (IC Markets, FP Markets, Fusion Markets, or similar).

Prop firm account issues:

- Make sure your daily risk limit in the EA inputs matches your prop firm's daily loss limit.
- If the EA stops trading mid-day, check whether the daily risk limit was reached.

License key issues (SwiftCap website purchases only):

- Log into your dashboard at <https://swiftcapeas.com/dashboard> to verify your license is active.
- Make sure you copied the full license key without extra spaces.
- Check that your subscription is active and not expired.
